AGGRAVATED AND DWELLING HOUSE BURGLARIES

BRAINTREE

Cant Way

October 29th between 01:15hrs and 01:25hrs.

Two unknown suspects wearing gloves and balaclavas and holding batons broke into a residential dwelling by smashing the glass of French doors, threatened the occupant and demanded money and left with jewellery box containing high value jewellery

Skitts Hill

October 27th between 17:00hrs and 22:10hrs.

Suspect unknown gained entry via back door and items removed.

GOSFIELD High Garrett
